## Driving directions

From HWY 11, take the Ravenscliffe Rd. exit and turn West onto Ravenscliffe Rd. Follow Ravenscliffe which will cross over the Big East river and head up and over a hill. At the bottom of the hill, take a right onto Sinclair Rd. At the first intersection, go straight and the driveway up to the course will be on the right hand side (it's a sharp turn to head up the driveway). ## Parking Info

After arriving at the property on Sinclair Rd., Play Outdoors Canada will be on the left, and a driveway heading up on the right. Take the driveway and head up the hill, after following it up and around to the left you will see parking all along the left side of the road. There is more parking available just a little further along on the right side.

## General Rules & Notes

- **2-METRE RULE:** The 2 metre rule is NOT in effect!
- **COURSE MARKINGS:** WHITE stakes indicate Out-of-Bounds, and RED stakes are Hazards.
- **CASUAL OBSTACLES:** As per 803.2, players may obtain relief from brush/log piles. Player may mark a new lie that is on the line of play, farther from the target, at the nearest point that provides relief.
- **OUT OF BOUNDS:** All water is OB. Roads are only OB when indicated on the tee sign or in this Caddy Book. OB and Hazards are staked in many cases (White = OB, Red = Hazard), however if a staked line ends, the OB line will continue to infinity along the same line as the last two stakes, or until this line intersects with other OB such as a road or water, or as otherwise noted in this Caddy Book.

## Special Holes

- Closest To Pin: Hole 1 for  $\geq 850$  (RAH)  
Hole 2 for  $< 850$  (RAF)
- Longest Putt: Hole 9 for all divisions

Red / Recreational Tee

Recommended for recreational players or those new to the sport.

Pink lines on the map indicate areas considered out of bounds / hazards.

Hiking Trails

Some disc golf holes overlap shared portions of park trails, keep an eye out for signs!



## Disc Golf Rules, Safety and Etiquette

**Objective of the Game**  
Disc Golf is played like traditional golf, but with disc golf discs instead of balls and clubs. One throw (stroke) is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The goal is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible. The player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins.

**Safety First**  
Never throw when other players or other pedestrians are within range. Always give pedestrians the right of way. Be aware of your surroundings and environment at all times.

**Tee Throws**  
Each hole begins with a tee throw. Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area.

**Lie**  
The spot where the player's previous throw has landed. Mark each lie with a mini marker disc or leave the thrown disc on the ground where it landed. The player's subsequent throw is made from directly behind the marked lie.

**Fairway Throws**  
Fairway throws must be made from directly behind the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed, unless the lie is within 10 meters of the target. Any shot within 10 meters of the target requires that the player maintain balance and not move past the lie until the disc comes to rest.

**Completion Of Hole**  
A disc that comes to rest in the disc golf basket or suspended in the chains constitutes the successful completion of that hole.

**Throwing Order**  
The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole. After all players have teed off, the player whose disc is farthest from the target throws first, and so on.

**Out Of Bounds**  
If any area of O.B. is visible between the disc and O.B. line, then the disc is considered O.B. A throw that lands out of bounds, must be played from a point up to 1 meter in bounds from where the disc crossed over the out of bounds line. O.B. zones are indicated on the course map, however, permanent water hazards, roads/parking areas, and property boundaries are also considered out of bounds.

# The Big East - Hole 1



## Hole Notes

1

### Out of Bounds:

This is an island hole, so the OB on the tee sign represents the outer edge of the island. White stakes line the edge of the island facing the tee, otherwise water and road edges complete the island.

Tee throws that do not land in-bounds must move to the designated Drop-Zone. All subsequent throws landing out-of-bounds mark their lie according to normal rules.



# The Big East - Hole 2



## Hole Notes

- 1 Hazard:**  
There is a staked (red) hazard area running along the left side of the hole. Any shot landing in this area takes their next shot from their lie within the hazard and adds 1 penalty stroke.
- 2 Out of Bounds:**  
The road beyond the basket, and to the right are considered out of bounds. The trail in front of the tee is NOT out-of-bounds.

## Hole Notes

- 1 Out of Bounds:**  
The water beyond the basket is staked and out of bounds, even if the bed is dry.



# The Big East - Hole 7



## Hole Notes

- 1 Out of Bounds:**  
All water is out of bounds including the pond to the right of the tee and the swamp beyond and along the right side of the hole. The swamp has been staked.



# The Big East - Hole 8



## Hole Notes

- 1 Out of Bounds:**  
The drainage ditch with water on the tee sign is NOT considered out of bounds, however the pond next to the bridge IS considered out of bounds.



# The Big East - Hole 9



## Hole Notes

- 1 Out of Bounds:**  
The small bunker pond to the left of the basket is out-of-bounds. The road is not considered out of bounds.
